This year St Ursula's Interact Club celebrates 40 years of existence and, together with the P&F Association, want to celebrate by giving back to the girls of our world, aiding them with education. This year, we aim to sponsor 40 girls for a year of education.

Girl Up, a campaign of the United Nations Foundation is about uniting girls to change the world. When girls are empowered, it benefits all of us.

Providing a girl with an education means that:

- **She is healthier** – an educated girl is more likely to seek healthcare, marry later and have fewer children.
- **She is economically powerful** – an educated girl will earn more money, reinvest 80-90 percent of her wages back into her family and community and help break the cycle of poverty.
- **She is poised to be a leader** – an educated girl will be more involved in her community, more prepared for decision-making and more confident in her own abilities.

For every \$25 raised at the *Girl Up Foundation High Tea*, one refugee girl will be educated for a year. This money will go to joint UN programs in Ethiopia, Guatemala, Liberia, Malawi and India.
