

COLLEGE UNIFORM



FORMAL UNIFORM

- White College Blouse and Tie
- College Skirt (covering the knee)
- Navy Blazer for all students in Years 10, 11 & 12. Optional for students in Year 7, 8 & 9
- Plain white crew, calf-length fold-over socks or Pantyhose (40 denier) – Navy
- Black leather regulation, lace-up school shoes of regular height
- College Badge
- Navy College Panama Hat (to be worn at all times when outdoors)
- College backpack (compulsory as it encourages good posture)

'FREE DRESS' DAYS

- The Sports Shirt is to be worn on specified Free Dress Days - Sports Carnivals, Retreat Days, Fundraising Days - with school shorts and appropriate closed-in shoes unless otherwise specified

COLLEGE SPORTS UNIFORM

- College Shorts
- College Sports Shirt
- Sports Shoes
- White Socks
- College Sports Hat
- One-piece swim suit (navy or black 'racer-back style')
- College Tracksuit

Students in Years 7, 8 & 9 only are permitted to wear their Sports Uniform to and from the College on days they have a practical Physical Education lesson.

OPTIONAL UNIFORM

(Except for days when Formal Uniform is required)

- College Dress (covering the knee)
- College Jumper

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

Students must maintain their uniform, keep it neat, clean and tidy, and replace items if they are worn or damaged. Sports Uniform and Formal Uniform accessories are not to be mixed

HAIR

- Hair must be tidy and neither grown nor groomed in an extreme or exaggerated fashion
- Hair must be in such a condition that it does not invite comment
- Extreme hairstyles such as shaved/buzz cut hair or brightly coloured hair is against the College rules. Hair colour should be as close to natural as possible
- Hair must be tied back for neatness and health and safety reasons. Hair ties or ribbons are to match uniform colours. Flowers, ornaments and head bands are not acceptable
- Hair that is longer than the collar should be tied back

JEWELLERY

- A watch may be worn
- No large back on studs
- One small plain earring (sleepers or studs) may be worn in the lower ear lobe. They are not to be larger than the lobe. They may be gold, silver or white
- No other piercings on any part of the body. Clear studs are not acceptable

OTHER

- Fingernails should be kept clean and short
- Fake nails and nail polish are not permitted
- Underclothing must be plain and not seen through the uniform

- Eye and face make-up is not to be worn with College uniform
- Students are not permitted to wear their Sports Uniform to or from the College
- Students in Years 10,11 & 12 are required to bring their Sports Uniform on the days required and change when required
- Footwear: Thongs are never to be worn to, from, or at the College

UNIFORM BREACHES

The correct wearing of the College uniform is critical to developing a sense of school pride and spirit. In addition to this, it helps to prepare students for the expectations associated with life after school. Students at St Ursula's College are continually encouraged to wear their uniform correctly; however, should breaches occur a red card will be issued and their name recorded. The student will be expected to attend a lunchtime detention.

If a student accrues three red cards in one term their name will be recorded and they will be expected to attend an afterschool detention. If the student continues to be non-compliant regarding uniform expectations, parents will be notified to discuss ongoing enrolment.
