

Instrumental Music Loan Agreement Form

You are required to always keep the instrument in good working order, advising of any issues immediately. Please speak to your Instrumental Music Tutor for advice on the care of the instrument.

- 1) You are responsible for any loss or damage caused to the instrument by theft, fire, etc., while it is in your possession.
- 2) You do not loan the instrument to any other person, or let any other person play the instrument.
- 3) The instrument **MUST** be returned to St Ursula's College when requested by your Tutor, in full working order.
- 4) Cost is \$25.00 per term for an instrument and is payable to the College. The instrument will be given out upon payment of the first term's fee. Fees for the following terms must be paid within the first 7 days of term or the instrument will have to be returned.
- 5) You are responsible for the purchase of consumables required for the instrument, such as strings, reeds, valve oil, etc.
